This ‘Term Plan’ is being presented at a very critical and decisive point in the history of our country and the Muslim community. Given the world scenario, there is no doubt that currently, our beloved country possesses extraordinary opportunities in many aspects. India has now become the most populous country in the world. This large population has provided it with an abundance of human resources. The overall wealth and financial resources of our country are also developing rapidly. Despite the strong global wave of materialism and debauchery, the deep effects of religion and its moral precepts are still there in our general population. These moral values are also a great strength of our country. If the resources and opportunities are valued and properly utilized, if there is an ambience of peace and fraternity in the country, if our moral conditions improve and if there is a fair and just distribution of resources, we can play an important role at the global level and become an exemplar of values for the world to emulate.

But unfortunately, at such a historic juncture which is full of opportunities for growth and development, the monster of communalism and hatred has gripped our country in its bloodstained clutches. The poison of communalism emanating from racist political ideas and narrow-minded short-term interests has vitiated government institutions and general society.

As a result, the country's social fabric, religious tolerance, and the rule of law have been seriously compromised, and it is becoming difficult to speak and listen to truth and justice. This aggressive communalism has also joined hands with the Islamophobic movement of global imperialism. Hence, defamation of Islam, linking it with terrorism, and the promotion of insurgency or extremism within the Muslim Ummah is now included in its goals. The main objectives of communal aggression are creating division in society, causing a climate of constant tension and animosity between different religious groups in the country, developing misunderstandings about Islam and Muslims, demoralizing Muslims, and triggering acts of violence against them.

The manifestation of this communal short-sightedness is that the ruling elite is neither focused on the possibilities and opportunities that are presently available to the country nor is it concerned with the real problems of the country. Corruption, crimes, oppression, exploitation, and moral crisis are touching alarming levels. Economic inequality is not only at its peak but is continuously increasing. Despite the enormous generation of wealth, its concentration in a few hands has deprived the great majority of the people of the benefits of economic development. Constitutional bodies are in decline, resulting in the rise of autocracy. Both the media, which is considered the conscience of the country, and the education system, which generates the intellectual power of the country, are succumbing to the communal forces.

However, the promising aspect is that a large number of thoughtful people in the country are realizing the likely dire consequences of this situation and are anxious to change it. This hysterical obsession with communalism is an unnatural situation. We hope that eventually, the conscience of this country will wake up against this destructive trend. In the past, the rise of extremist movements and the resulting bloodshed in many countries of the world have paved the way for concrete reforms in the systems. Therefore, it will not be a misplaced hope that disturbance and

mischievous created by the communal forces will become a means for lasting reforms in the country in the near future. In-Sha-Allah!

In these circumstances, the responsibility of the Muslim Ummah increases twofold. It must stand up as the saviour of the country. Muslims are a group that is based on beliefs, principles and ideas. They are “khair e ummat” (the best community), which implies that their responsibility cannot be limited to themselves. They are “ukhrijat lin naas” (raised for humankind) and so they are responsible for all humanity. They are “shuhada alan naas” (witness unto humankind), which means they have to bear witness to the truth over all other communities. They are “ummat e wasat” (the moderate community), who has been entrusted with the task of protecting people from all kinds of intemperance. They are “qawwamina bil qist” (upholders of justice) and so their mission is to provide justice for every servant of Allah. This mission is not only a requirement of their religion and its principles but also the way to a better future and a dignified life in this country. Muslims must come out of their cocoons and stand up for the good of the whole country and its people both for this world and the hereafter. Their identity should no longer be that of an alienated community, cut off from the mainstream, with strange traditions and mysterious values, rather it should be that of a dynamic, active and caring group, conscious of the well-being and welfare of all the people of our country. Allah’s divine purpose behind the current situation seems to be that Muslims should become aware, change their previous behaviour, and come forward with a new identity and renewed fervour and zeal.

The objective of Jamaat-e-Islami Hind is “iqamat-e-deen”. It is actually the objective of the whole Muslim Ummah. With this objective of the Muslim Ummah, Jamaat-e-Islami Hind strives its utmost in presenting the message of Islam in this country. It is appealing to people to surrender completely to their Creator and Master and accept His obedience in every domain of life. Islam frees humanity from the servitude of every other entity besides God and all forms of slavery. Islam invites humankind

to accept the servitude of only one God. In doing so, humanity can be saved from the displeasure of Allah and His punishment. The religion of Islam is based on the laws of nature. It offers the natural and correct solution to all the problems of the individual as well as society. Islam guarantees justice, peace, prosperity and holistic development to all individuals and groups of people, regardless of race and ethnicity.

In pursuit of this objective, Jamaat-e-Islami Hind is bound by the Book of Allah and the Sunnah of Prophet ﷺ. In the light of its objective, it adopts moral, constructive, peaceful, democratic and constitutional methods and avoids all those means that are against goodwill, trust, honesty and integrity or which cause communal hatred, class struggle and corruption in the world.

Amid the circumstances, mentioned above, the most important requirement of this objective is that the public opinion of the country should change positively in favour of Islam. The change of public opinion is the most important proactive agenda of the Muslims and also its defensive agenda. Proactive because the true position of a Muslim is one who invites people towards Allah and the change of public opinion towards Islam is an important goal for someone who invites people towards Allah. “Defensive” because, at present, the main agenda of the anti-Islamic forces is to defame Islam and create misunderstandings and aversion around it.

All over the world and in our country as well, the root cause of the atrocities against Muslims is the widespread erroneous notion and idea about Islam. Until this negative perception is corrected, the situation cannot improve. It urgently demands that Muslims should start this important task with all their strength and focus a large part of their efforts towards it. The work of inviting people to Islam and moulding public opinion should not be limited to a few groups but should become the agenda of the entire Muslim Ummah.

The ‘Term Plan’ has been formulated against this background.

Some of the distinguishing features of this plan are as follows:

1. This 'Term Plan' is focused on a 'Term Mission', and bringing about a positive change in public opinion has been declared as the mission of this term. All Zones, Local Units, affiliated organizations and the cadre of Jamaat will concentrate all their efforts on this mission and endeavour that their activities and efforts become a means of bringing about a concrete positive change in public opinion within their respective circles of influence. Various tasks will be performed by Jamaat. Local Units and Zones of Jamaat will also adopt diverse and innovative means. However, all work undertaken will be with a unity of purpose and part of the same mission. Every member, worker and every individual associated with the Jamaat will have the same dream to change the public opinion of the people in his area in a positive direction (in favour of Islam).
2. In order to achieve this mission, the most important thing is that we bear witness unto humankind regarding Islam through our words and deeds. The chasm that exists between Muslims and other communities of our country should be minimized. Our relations and contacts with our brothers and sisters should expand. Muslims themselves should become role models of Islam. Muslim society should undergo rapid reformation and become a real Islamic society. The cadre of Jamaat should go through comprehensive "tazkiya" (purification and self-development) and they should make their identity as selfless servants of humanity and emerge as advocates, mentors and leaders in their respective places. Therefore, the tasks of inviting people to Islam (dawah), reforming the society, purification, training, and serving the people, have been declared as 'basic and mandatory tasks'. This is the first and most important part of the plan. This is an essential function of Jamaat and its true identity. This

work will be mandatory for every organizational unit and every individual of the Jamaat. Every individual will be a 'daee' (one who invites people to Islam) and a reformer. Every individual will be a selfless servant of society and along with training oneself, he/she will also be a mentor to his/her colleagues. The Local Units of Jamaat will give maximum emphasis to this work. Jamaat will make a conscious effort to bring about a concrete change on this fundamental front through the continuous individual efforts of its members and the collective efforts of its units, through which a positive change in public opinion (in favour of Islam) takes place.

3. This mission also depends on the Muslim Ummah getting rid of its faults and weaknesses. The weakness and backwardness of the Muslim community is also an important reason for its victimization and an obstacle to offering the correct testimony of Islam. Immediate resolution of these problems is also necessary to restore the true character of the Muslim Ummah. Therefore, issues related to the development of the Muslim community and its safety and security have also been given great importance in this 'Term Plan'. Similarly, the restoration of law and order in the country, the establishment of justice, communal harmony, inter-religious dialogue, promotion of education, giving education the right direction, the education of children, media and domains like social media, research and producing literature have also been included in it and accorded due importance. At the level of Markaz, Jamaat will exert all-out efforts on these domains too. However, while preparing a plan regarding these domains, the local conditions and problems will be taken into consideration and the Zones, Local Units and members of Jamaat will include appropriate points from these domains in their plan according to their conditions, circumstances, strengths and capabilities.



4. This time, institutions have also been accorded due importance in the ‘Term Plan’. Efforts will be made to ensure that the institutions under the influence of The Islamic Movement and the institutions of the Muslim community also become a part of Jamaat’s mission, namely bringing about a positive change in public opinion regarding Islam. These institutions should become a source of mercy to all sections of the society and their goals, actions and conduct should become a source of knowing the distinctive and pristine teachings of Islam.
5. Women have been given special importance in this plan. Efforts will be made to increase their involvement at all levels and make full use of their abilities and strengths. Similarly, importance has been given to the youth. Efforts will be made for the youth at all levels to come forward and use their energies for the development of the country and the Muslim community. Children’s work has been prominently included as a permanent part of this plan. The expansion and consolidation of the Jamaat, especially its rapid growth in the Muslim-majority areas of the country, is also an important goal of this Term Plan, which will be given special attention In-Sha-Allah!

I appeal to all the members of the Jamaat and the entire Muslim Ummah to prepare yourselves to join this endeavour in such a way that this mission becomes your biggest passion and the biggest dream in the coming months and years. It consumes all your senses and paves the way for the beginning of a concrete and perceptible change in every nook and corner of the country.

## TERM MISSION

Islam is the religion sent by the Lord of all humanity for all humankind. It is a path, which leads to salvation both in this world and in the Hereafter. Islamic teachings guarantee peace, prosperity and justice to society and the country. The mission for the current term is to bring about a positive change in public opinion in favour of Islam and undertake the necessary individual and collective character building for bringing about that positive change.

### **Requirements:**

1. All individual, collective and institutional activities of Jamaat and its cadre shall be focused on this mission.
2. Jamaat will prepare its cadre for this mission and give them a practical program.
3. Jamaat will try to make all its institutions and the Muslim Ummah to focus their activities on the same mission.
4. Jamaat will try to establish peace and justice in the country and to eliminate oppression, corruption, hatred and discrimination.
5. The Muslim community must play its designated role, for which its religious and moral reform is necessary, and at the same time its protection and development is essential. Jamaat will focus on both these aspects.

The following plan shall be implemented towards the achievement of the above-mentioned mission.

## **1. Basic and Mandatory Work**

### **Dawah, Reformation, Purification and Service**

Advocacy of Islam (Dawah), reformation (Islah), purification and self-development (Tazkiyah) and service (Khidmat) will be the main tasks of Jamaat. They will be implemented in a coordinated manner. The teachings of Islam will be highlighted through this work. These tasks will be mandatory for all members and workers, Local Units and Zones of Jamaat. A substantial portion of our efforts and energies will be expended on these tasks. Mosques and various institutions will also keep these tasks in focus.

### **Guidelines**

- Establishing close relations with fellow citizens and encouraging Muslims to do the same.
- Continuously performing the duty of “witnessing” Islam through words and deeds and introducing Islam to as many people as possible at the individual and collective level.
- Keeping an eye on the ongoing debates related to Islam that occur within your scope and sphere of influence and elucidating the truth by giving proper direction to these debates.
- Highlighting the positive aspects of the Muslim Ummah and providing opportunities for all fellow citizens to observe and experience them. For example, by providing occasions to observe congregational prayers, distribution of Sadaqatul Fitr and Zakat, ideal (Muslim) wedding ceremonies, distribution of inheritance and

Muslim funerals, etc.

- Identifying such issues regarding the Muslim community in your Unit and Zone about which public opinion is negative, and bringing about positive changes in the community related to those issues.
- Creating courage and confidence within the Muslim Ummah. Building awareness about their position and purpose, developing the spirit of sticking to their religion and being steadfast in its principles and encouraging Muslims to adopt legal and ethical methods for the establishment of justice and fairness and for opposing and ending oppression and injustice.
- Striving continuously for the reformation of the Muslim Ummah, understanding the fundamental deviations from Islam, found in their area of work and circle of influence, and striving systematically with a sense of priority to purge the Muslim society of these deviations.
- Making the Muslim society a source of giving the practical testimony of Islam. Setting good examples before the people of the country and removing their defects in order to accomplish this.
- Transforming mosques and Muslim institutions so that they become a source of witnessing Islam and living examples of the various teachings of Islam.
- Developing a spirit of service among the cadre of Jamaat and the Muslim community at the individual level and motivating them to solve the problems of their townships and providing the basic amenities of life for the people.
- Making the Muslim Ummah a mercy to mankind and preparing them to be selfless servants of all human beings.
- Introducing the Jamaat and its message to as many

people as possible within their area of work and circle of influence, to increase the human resources of Jamaat and to transform the Jamaat into an effective force.

- Enabling the members of Jamaat to focus on their self-development in such a way that their relationship with Allah is strengthened and their personality is significantly improved.
- Preparing the individuals of Jamaat for all these tasks in such a way that they emerge as mentors, callers to the way of Allah, leaders and role models in the society.

## **Targets**

1. The Delhi Jamaat will introduce Islam to as many as twenty times of its workforce ( $782 \times 20 = 15,640$ ) to fellow compatriots and make them volunteers of the organisation.
2. Members and workers will convey the message of Islam to fellow citizens in such a way that at least ten citizens per member and worker ( $782 \times 10 = 7820$ ) get acquainted with the message of truth, 20% of those citizens ( $1564 =$  influential class) should belong to the influential class.
3. The Jamaat, with the cooperation of the Muslim community, will carry out work in such a way that at six Local Units, convey the message of Islam to at least 5% of the Local population.
4. Members and workers will familiarize Muslims with the comprehensive concept of religion in such a way that at least 20 ( $782 \times 20 = 15,640$ ) Muslims per member and worker of Jamaat become familiar with the comprehensive concept of Islam, 20% of those Muslims ( $3128$ ) should belong to the influential class.
5. Each local unit will carry out its work with the support of the Muslim community in such a way that at least

25% of the local Muslim population (5,50000) be prepared for reformation in basic matters (e.g. beliefs and family life).

6. Every member and worker (Total: 782) will prepare and implement his/her annual training and development plan as per the training manual issued by headquarters.
7. Every member and worker will help at least 100 needy people (Total 78200 persons), irrespective of the community they belong to, in such a way that their suffering is reduced or their problem is resolved.
8. The Delhi zone will try to make one 'model locality' (Nai Basti / Seelampur slum area) based on Islamic teachings.
9. The Delhi zone with the cooperation of the Muslim community will try to make three mosques (Masjid Umar, Jaitpur / Al Huda Masjid, Mansarovar Park / Takiya Wali Masjid, Nabi Kareem) as 'Ideal Mosques', which will cater to the needs of education and training for Muslims, conduct social activities and display Islamic teachings for fellow citizens.
10. Islamic Information Centers will be tried to establish at one place with the help of the JIH HQRS.
11. Family counseling centers will be established in those local units, which are strong in terms of manpower.
12. Majlis-e-Ulama will be reorganized and active and it will be directed towards social reform initiatives.

## 2. Organization

Markaz and Zones will pay special attention to the expansion of the Jamaat in new areas within their respective jurisdictions and towards the consolidation of existing organizational units along with continuous increase in their cadre. In addition, special attention will be given to the comprehensive training of members and associates and promotion of healthy organizational culture. Special attention will be given to the involvement of women and girl-students in all the spheres of activities.

### **Guidelines:**

- Paying special attention to the expansion and consolidation of the Zone and utilizing the human resources of other Zones in this regard.
- Expanding Jamaat in their jurisdictions by Local Units and endeavoring for rapid increase in the human resource of Jamaat.
- Paying special attention by Members and workers to enhancing their public relations and making a concerted effort to involve new people in Jamaat. In this regard, attention will be paid to involving those from Tehreeki circles as well as the members of every section of the Muslim society.
- Paying special attention by all the Local Units towards the religious and Tehreeki training of all associates and exerting efforts to uplift them from their present level.
- Promoting a healthy organizational environment at the Local Unit level that would maximize opportunities

for individuals to learn and develop themselves, as well as facilitate the induction of new individuals into the organization.

- Producing desired outcome should be the focus of the activities. Zones must ensure better planning, effective implementation and seamless review and accountability along with strengthening of organizational discipline in their Local Units.
- Paying special attention to engaging the youth at Local levels, ensuring their enrolment in Jamaat and emphasizing on strengthening the youth organizations.
- Paying special attention to work among women and girl-students at Local Units and trying to induct them into Jamaat.

#### **Targets:**

1. The Jamaat will be introduced in three districts (New Delhi, North Delhi, and South-West Delhi) where it currently has no presence, and at least one unit will be formed.
2. By the end of the current term, at least two local units will be established in two districts (North East Delhi and South East Delhi) where the Muslim population is 25% or more.
3. By the end of the term, the numerical strength of the cadre will be increased at least a twofold. Every member and worker will ensure that at least one person from his family, neighborhood, and profession circle associates with the Jamaat. Efforts will be made to ensure that at least 30% of the new cadre enrollment (1564) consists of women (470) and another 30% consists of youth (470).
4. The Zone will increase its human resource in such a way that the ratio of members to workers among the cadre

will be 1:10 by the end of the term. (By the end of the term, the numerical strength of the cadre will be 6640.)

### **3. Other Departments and Institutions**

The Zone will also focus on the domains listed below. The Zone and Local Units too will keep these tasks at the centre of their attention, keeping in view their strength and design necessary plans towards achieving them. The Zone and Local Units can select among these different domains based on their prevailing situations, needs and organizational strengths.

#### **1. Community Affairs:**

The Jamaat will take a timely stand on important issues confronting the Muslim community and ensure that the important issues related to the protection and development of the Muslim Ummah get a prominent place in the national agenda, and ensue to give them a positive turn. The attempts aimed at endangering the lives, properties, and religious identity of Muslims will be resisted. Jamaat will also ensure the Muslim community to come out of its political marginalization and disrepute. In this context, the Zone and Local Units will carry out the following tasks as per the need and demand of the situation.

#### **Guidelines:**

- Taking appropriate measures for the economic development and stability of Muslims.
- Encouraging Muslims to improve their physical and mental health and providing appropriate guidance for physical fitness and sports activities.
- Maintaining a working relationship with Parliamentarians, legislatures, administrators, religious and community leaders and media persons to draw the attention of

legislation, administration and media towards serious public issues. Efforts will be made to disseminate the right information to present an Islamic standpoint on those issues.

- Building and promoting effective narratives to undermine the Islamophobic propaganda.
- Preparing Muslims to take all necessary measures within the purview of law and the Shariah to defend themselves and other oppressed people from attacks on their lives, property and dignity, and get the support of justice-loving people in the country in this regard.
- Rapport building with the professionals, intellectuals, bureaucrats, lawyers, industrialists and business houses of the country and solicit their services for the protection and development of the Muslim community.

### **Targets:**

1. To establish a new interest-free society with the cooperation of like-minded institutions.
2. Vocational training for small business will be provided to one hundred people in collaboration with various institutions so that they can become self-employed. (With the help of local units).
3. Small loans will be provided for one hundred people with the support of like-minded institutions. (With the help of local units).
4. Maximum utilization of the budget allocated in government and welfare schemes for Muslims will be ensured.

## 2. National Affairs:

Jamaat will try to strive to establish peace and order in the country and endeavour to secure justice in every strata of the society. It will raise its voice against social injustices in society. Further, it will elucidate the requirements of justice and fairness in the light of Islamic teachings and make every possible effort to achieve them. In this regard, the following activities will be carried out at the level of the Zone and Local Units as per the need and demand of the situation.

### Guidelines:

- Striving at all levels to combat communalism, communal hatred and fascism.
- Promoting democratic values in the country and striving for justice in tandem with various cultural entities of the country. Collaborative efforts would be made towards achieving the end in cooperation with various organizations, institutions and personalities at the Zonal and local levels.
- Striving for the establishment of social justice in the country.

- Making efforts to correct social evils existing in the country such as casteism, bigotry, immorality, culpable homicides, depriving girls of their rights, etc.
- Spelling out the Islamic perspective regarding the environmental crisis.
- Establishing non-profit institutions of interest-free lending, mutual aid institutions, public and primary health centres, Nagarik Seva Kendras, counselling centres and educational institutions with the support of the society as per the need and demand of the situation. Efforts will be made to ensure that these institutions benefit all regardless of religious and caste considerations.

### **Targets:**

1. Institutions for the protection of civil rights and legal assistance and guidance shall be strengthened in Delhi Zone.
2. Adequate measures will be taken at Zonal and Local Unit levels on environmental issues as per the need.
3. Civil society networks will be strengthened and efforts will be made to ensure that these networks strive for peace and harmony and justice and fairness, with collaborative efforts.
4. Efforts will be made to raise public awareness at local the level about important social problems of Indian society such as casteism, ignorance, bigotry, indecency, culpable homicide, drug addiction, deprivation of girls of their due rights, etc.)

### 3. Media and Digital Media:

Emphasis will be placed on the use of modern mass media to mold public opinion. Moreover, cooperation and collaboration will be extended to individuals and institutions working in these fields. The following tasks will be undertaken in this regard:

#### Guidelines:

- To make an agenda of public debate by bringing an issue related to Indian society in media and social media, every quarter, conducting public debates and through personal contacts. Public opinion will be sensitized on that issue.
- Strengthening of the Jamaat's own media cell and thereby presenting the Jamaat's position in the media and establishing contact with media persons.
- Preparing selected persons and spokespersons to participate effectively in media debates, by imparting respective skills and training.

#### Targets:

1. The Zone will apprise Muslim and non-Muslim journalists and intellectuals of Islamic positions on

various issues.

2. Our stand will be presented on a national issue every six months at the Zonal level in such a way that people get to know the distinctive Islamic teachings regarding it.
3. Efforts will be made, through timely intervention and discussions, to mold the public opinion in the right direction on the issues related to Islam and Muslims that become the subject of public debate at the zonal level.

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#### **4. Education:**

By participating in the process of educational reforms at the policy-making level, Jamaat will try to make education accessible to all citizens, lending assistance to design the curriculum based on known and authentic facts and include universal moral values in pedagogy. Further, it will also endeavour that the religious identity of any class is not tampered with. Jamaat will also be attending to the education of Muslims, their literacy and their presence in higher education to catch up with the national average (Gross Enrollment Ratio). The following activities will be carried out as required in the field of education at the zonal and local unit levels:

#### **Guidelines:**

- Monitoring the government pedagogy and education policy and focusing on the aspects requiring reforms. Seeking support from teachers' organizations at the state level towards this end.
- Consolidating and activating the State Taleemi Board to harmonize the curriculum of Muslim educational institutions, including religious schools, with the requirements of Islamic education in contemporary times and to protect their constitutional rights.
- Creating educational awareness in the Muslim Ummah, striving for their development and awakening the community towards mass enrollment in primary and higher education

#### **Targets:**

Support will be given to such schools that concur with the idea of Islamic education in improving their

management, quality of education and performance of their educational institutions. The support will be lent to training at both pedagogical and administrative levels.

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## 5. Training of Children:

All-round training and development of children is the first step towards the development of any society. It is very important for the Islamic Movement to pay special attention to the education and training of children. From their early days, right from earlier childhood days, they should get exposure to Islamic teachings; they should be embellished with morals and character and inculcated with love for Islam and the Islamic Movement. The following tasks will be carried out to achieve this goal.

### Guidelines:

- Carrying out various innovative activities to inculcate the love of Allah and the Prophet ﷺ in children.
- Conducting regular gatherings of children at the local level and providing them with opportunities to participate in various religious and welfare activities.
- Creating awareness of Islam through special holiday courses and other useful activities during vacations, to inspire them to be practicing Muslims, and to create consciousness in them about the importance of group living with a cause.
- To Inculcate the spirit of excellence and competition in doing good deeds in today's competitive life with the help of sports and various academic competitions.
- To Inculcate the desire to excel in the field of education and provide necessary guidance for the same.

## 6. Research and Book Writing:

In an era of intellectual crisis and deviant tendencies, Jamaat will endeavour to see the reconstruction of thoughts and systems based on an Islamic worldview, in such a way that it gains footholds. In addition, Jamaat will evaluate critically the dominant intellectual and academic trends of the present time



and alternatives will be presented. For this, the Jamaat and its affiliated academic institutions will focus on the following issues:

### **Guidelines:**

- To organize academic and research activities and make the scholars realize this duty.
- To provide scholarly answers to important topics related to various spheres of life as well as to important questions that confront the Islamic Movement and the Muslim community today.
- To critically evaluate the policies being adopted in the country, provide alternatives at a highly intellectual level, and present these research efforts in the form of literature.
- To develop a comprehensive policy and plan for research and development at the level of Markaz.
- To manage academic and research projects, exchange experiences, and provide necessary guidance by creating a federation of academic and research institutions at the national and regional levels.
- To attract and support researchers to carry out research in institutions of higher research on Tehreeki topics and requirements.
- To collaborate with top research institutes as needed for research on important social topics.
- To conduct ‘action research’ regarding social change, according to Islamic ideology.

### **Targets:**

1. At the zonal level, the study circle will be further strengthened. Academic conferences will be held in relation to Tahreeki thought, challenges and policies. Literature will be published as per requirements.
2. Efforts will be made to collect the intellectual questions,

emerging due to attempts to distort the image of Islam and Muslims. The high-level initiatives (e.g. conducting surveys, seminars, and lectures and writing specific articles etc.) will be taken to provide their response.

## **7. Institutions:**

The Islamic Movement paid attention to the establishment and guidance of institutions from the early period of its inception to achieve the desired results through the efficient and systematic use of available skills in relevant fields. It is imperative for these institutions to function in a professional manner to achieve the basic purpose of their formation. At the same time, these institutions should also be a reflection of the teachings and values of Islam. The functioning of these institutions should be such that they represent Islam in their respective domains. Jamaat will try to make the institutions functioning under its management or supervision, and running by individuals who share the common thought about education with Jamaat, a means of public opinion building in favour of Islam. For this, the office bearers of these institutions will be trained and apprised to comply with the following issues:

### **Guidelines:**

- Selecting institutions and reforming them in a planned manner at Local level so that they represent a concrete and living example of the various aspects of the Islamic system of life.
- The following points should be kept in mind regarding the establishment of institutions and their effective functioning:
  1. Need, scope and utility
  2. Awareness of legal regulations
  3. Professional individuals
  4. Financial resources
  5. Leadership
  6. Respecting Islamic concepts and principles related to the functioning of the institution and making it a living embodiment of Islamic way of life

7. Standard Operating Procedures

8. Accounting and Auditing

9. Effectiveness

- Efforts should be made that the institutes should create specialization in their specific domains and should create their identity as exemplary and ideal institutes.
- Institutions should bear witness to Islam with their functioning and reflect Islamic values and teachings in their respective domains.
- Establish a suitable system for solving problems related to administrative and other matters.

1. Guidelines for the effective functioning of institutions, issued by the Markaz will be provided to institutions and efforts will be made to ensure their implementation.
2. The centralized system set up to supervise, guide and audit the work of institutions will be utilized at the zonal level
